This includes, but is not limited to, introductory courses, specialty courses, as well as general FCS education courses. 100% Membership recognition will not be given to those chapters who do not submit the completed 100% Membership Reporting Form by the annual deadline.

To encourage and reward chapters for having 100% membership, Michigan FCCLA will recognize each 100% Membership Chapter at the State Conference, in the student newsletter, and on the website.
